# Energy Policy

The combustion of fossil fuels that underpins this energy use has an associated impact on the environment through depletion of finite natural resources, air pollution and climate change. As such, SMT GB is duly committed to minimising this impact and fulfilling any applicable energy compliance obligations.

To achieve this, SMT GB maintains an energy management system, which is certified to the ISO 50001:2018 standard and focused on continual improvement of energy performance.

In line with the core value of 'environmental care', SMT GB is specifically committed to reducing the environmental impacts of its energy use through the following objectives:

- Reduce the intensity of energy use by implementing energy efficiency measures across its operations.
- Avoid unnecessary business travel and transport, and reduce the intensity of fuel consumption by its van fleet.
- Progressively substitute fossil fuels with low and zero carbon energy sources.
- Consider opportunities to improve energy and transport efficiency via procurement activities.
- Include energy efficiency as a key consideration for any design activity associated with business facilities, systems, equipment and processes.
- Ensure the availability of information and necessary resources to support the achievement of energy objectives.
- Monitor, measure, analyse and report on energy consumption using a set of energy performance indicators.
